Here are some of the things we do! Why not come and join us?

| Coffee at the Smith Museum, Dumbarton Road, Stirling

From 10.45 on the first Wednesday of every month. Meet old friends and make new ones. Just come along, get yourself a coffee and join any table for great chat with a cross section of former University staff.

| Walks

Recent walks have covered a wide range of venues and levels of expertise – from Gartmorn Dam, to Dumyat, to Ben Ledi. Walks take place several times a year, and culminate in a Christmas walk in December followed by lunch at a nice inn!
